Niagara Falls

Niagara Falls is one of the (31) beautiful natural sites in North America. It consists of a series of waterfalls on the Niagara River, which (32) between the state of New York in the United States and the province¹ of Ontario in Canada. The *Iroquois* people named the falls Niagara. (33) "thunder of waters," because of the roaring noise the water makes as it plunges² downward.

Goat Island divides the falls (34) two main parts. The larger part of the falls is in Canada and is known as Horseshoe Falls because of (35) curved shape. It measures about 792 meters along its curve and is about 48 meters high. The smaller American Falls is about 320 meters across and about 51 meters high. An even smaller waterfall, Bridal Veil Falls, is next to the American Falls.

Every (36) thousands of tons of water from the Niagara River pour over the cliffs of Niagara Falls. The (37) of water flowing over the falls varies, however, at different times of the day and year. Some of the river's water is directed into great tunnels before it can spill over the falls. The tunnels carry the water to electric power plants³ on the river below the falls. There the water is (38) to create electricity for thousands of people in the (39) areas on both sides of the river. The flow of water sent to the power plants is adjusted to meet the electricity (40) of a day or season. The United States and Canada share control of the Niagara River and the falls.
